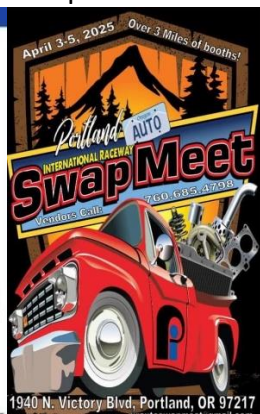

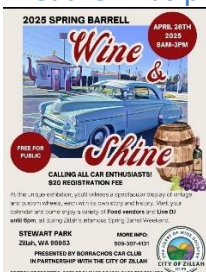

Historic Yakima

DING HO was one of the oldest Chinese restaurants in Yakima. It had red leather booths, lunch counter stools with red leather tops, and inexpensive food and drinks. The building constructed in 1942, was first called Skyline, then DING HO Cafe, and finally DING HO CHINESE FOOD in 1955. It was one of THE spots in Yakima during the 1950's. DING HO was located at 1502 West Washington, but closed in September 2019, after 64 years. It later reopened as Tasty Wok at 3312 West Nob Hill.

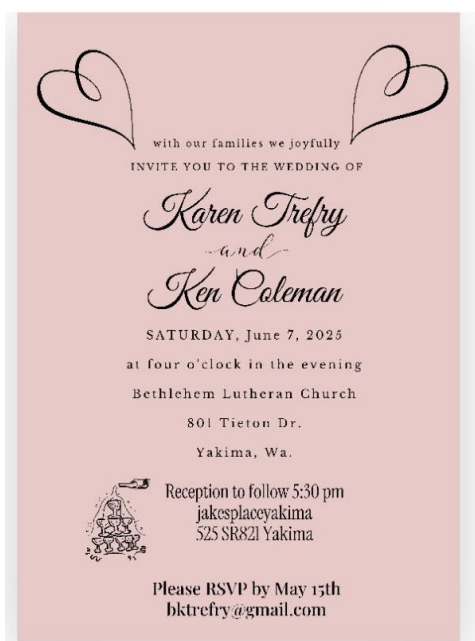

Council members set times, dates for 2025 Yakima Avenue car cruises

Classic car cruise nights will be on their usual summer weekend dates and a little later than recent years after the Yakima City Council approved a resolution on the matter at its Tuesday meeting.

The "open cruise events" on Yakima Avenue will be from 7-11 p.m. on the second and third Saturdays of June, July, August and September this summer after a unanimous vote to set the dates and time for 2025.

Deputy Mayor Matt Brown and Mayor Patricia Byers recently met with representatives of three Yakima Valley car clubs to discuss the schedule and other issues involving the

cruise nights.

"All of the car clubs want to shift (the time) back one hour," Brown said, noting the previous schedule of 6-10 p.m. included hot and sunny conditions at the start of the event.

Cruisin' the Ave. is a longtime summer tradition in downtown Yakima, with the route taking vehicles along Yakima Avenue, from Seventh Avenue to the turnaround at Naches Avenue.

Many car enthusiasts gather at adjacent parking lots to visit and show off their rides. Spectators often fill the sidewalks, and many bring lawn chairs.

In 2023 and previous years, issues surrounding cruise nights have included business owners

worried about access to their property, noise from semitrucks participating in the cruises, and the cost of overtime shifts for Yakima Police Department personnel working the event.

The latter issue was mentioned Tuesday night by council member Janice Deccio, and Brown said the car club representatives "are fully aware of budget constraints" that could impact the 2025 cruising season.

He added that better communication and education among the car clubs and their members could reduce the number of police officers needed to patrol the event.
